



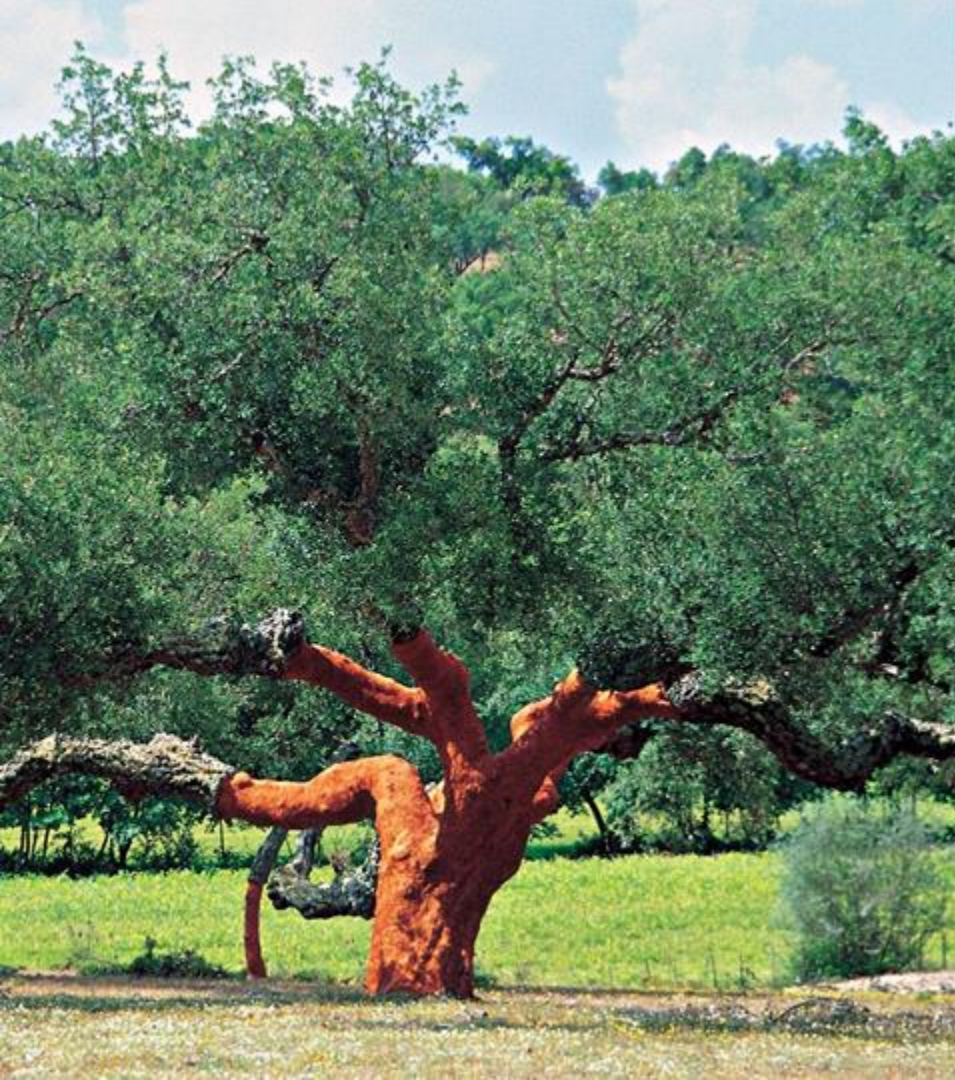

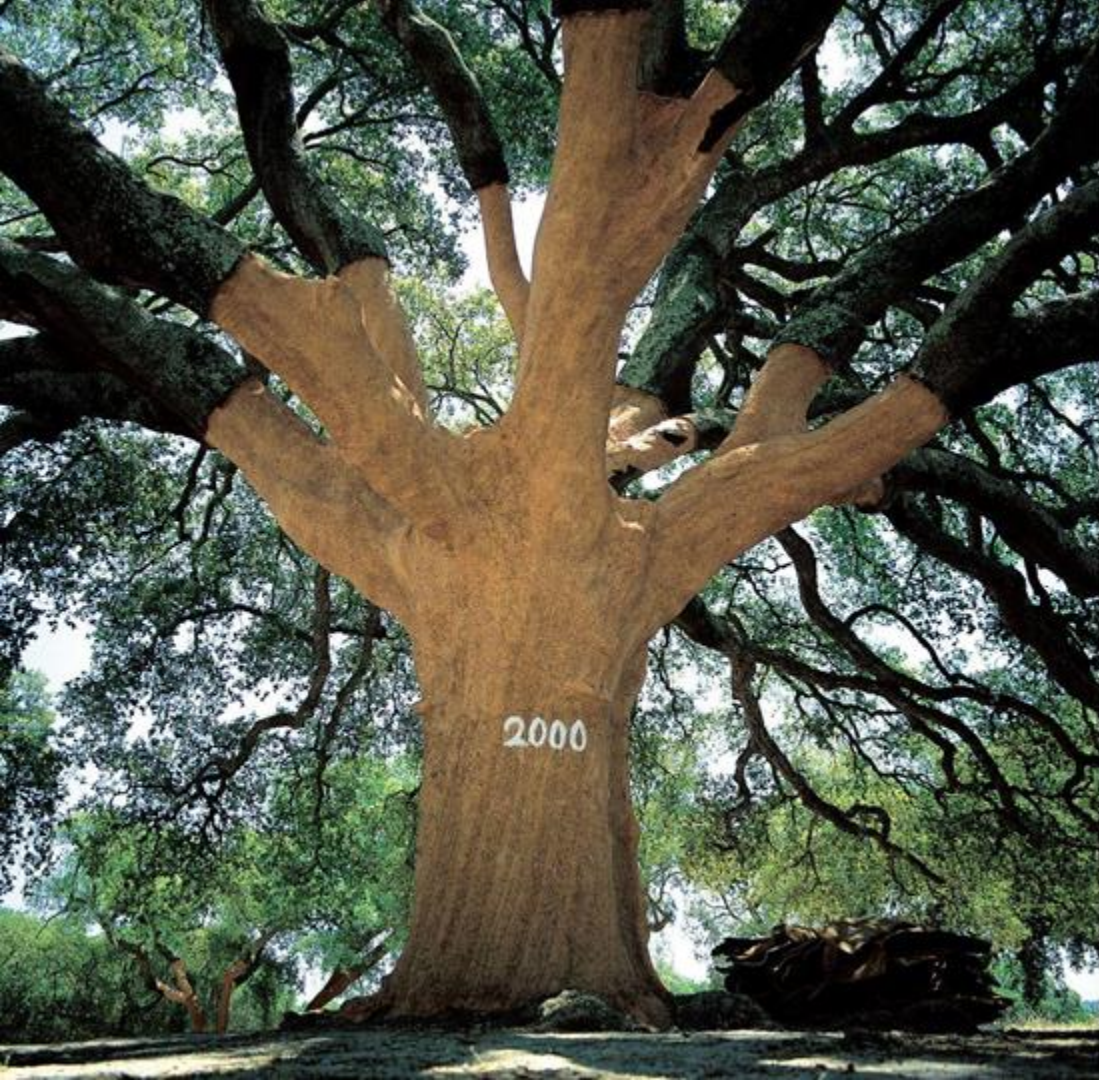

sustainably harvested
every **9-12 years.**





Each tree can be harvested 15-18 times.

Proper harvesting is great for the tree! Harvesting the bark actually **extends the life of the tree from 75 years to over 200 years!**

The 200 represents the last year of harvest to inform future harvesting dates within the 9-12 year window.
